What's New, FSS?



On December 18, 2014, WW II veterans Earl J. Gonzales and Preston Johnson were awarded the Medal of Chevalier in the French National Order of the Legion of Honor at the **45th Infantry Division Museum in Oklahoma City**.

The award was created by Napoleon Bonaparte in 1802, and is France's highest decoration.

Johnson, of Midwest City, was an infantryman who stepped on a land mine, losing the lower half of his right leg; his family said in a biography he's never let his injuries stop his ability to enjoy life. "I'm proud I served. I feel this is a great honor. I wasn't expecting this," Johnson said after the ceremony.

Gonzales, 92, of Oklahoma City, was a member of New Orleans' Washington Artillery Regiment that fought not only in France but in Sicily and Italy including the battle of Salerno and of Monte Cassino. His two brothers fought in the same artillery unit. Gonzales said, "I didn't do anything anymore than anybody else. The French are loveable, nice people. Whatever I did to help them, I'm glad and I'd do it again."

Grant Moak, honorary French consul, presented the Legion of Honor to the two veterans. He told them they did not fight a war of conquest and spoils, but a war of liberation. "Today, in this ceremony, a grateful France honors two of those veterans for their service in the cause of freedom and the liberation of France," Moak said.


