What's New, FSS?



The Oklahoma State University mascot, “Pistol Pete”, is based on the real-life famed lawman and legendary gunslinger US Marshal Frank B. “Pistol Pete” Eaton. Born 1860 in Connecticut, his family moved to a homestead in Kansas when he was eight. Shortly after, Eaton witnessed his father, a Union Army veteran of the Civil War shot dead in front of him by a gang of six former Confederate soldiers over a dispute.

As time passed, the young Eaton sought help from a family friend to learn how to handle a gun with the intention of one day avenging his father’s murder. By the time he was 15, he had developed such skill that he earned the nickname Pistol Pete. Soon he began competing in shooting competitions with the Army’s best marksmen, always winning.

At 17, he became a US Deputy Marshal in the Western District at Fort Smith, Arkansas with jurisdiction from southern Kansas to northern Texas. Eaton made his home in Bartlesville, OK until 1889, when he joined in the Oklahoma Land Rush and settled near Perkins, OK.

Over time, Eaton reportedly tracked down and killed five of the six men that were involved in his father’s murder. The sixth man is said to have been killed during a card game. Pistol Pete died in 1958 at the age of 97. He was married twice, and had ten children, 31 grandchildren, and is said to have had 15 notches on his gun belt.
